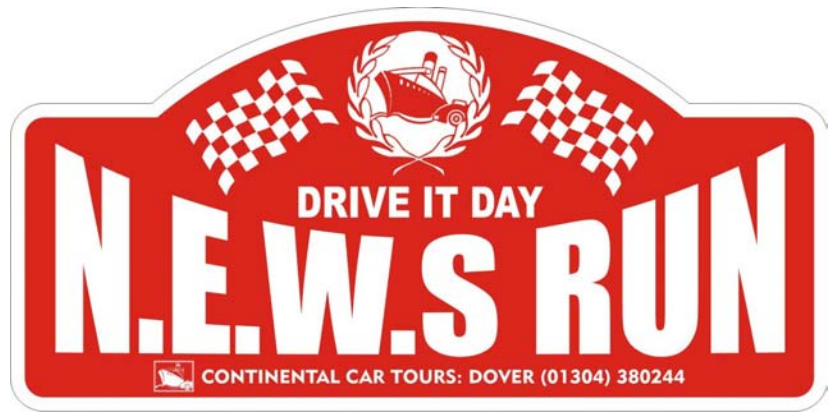

The 2010 N.E.W.S run will coincide with the national *Drive It Day* – see www.fbhvc.co.uk/drive-it-day.

The event has four start points, located in the North, East, West and South of England – hence the N.E.W.S. Run. All routes are approximately 120 miles long and converge on the Heritage Motor Centre at Gaydon, Warwickshire, for the finish.

Entrants choose their own route, visiting and photographing six out of ten given locations, aiming to finish in the shortest distance possible. Mileage will be recorded at the start and finish, and prizes awarded for the shortest route from each start point. Winners will be required to provide photographic evidence of their route. *Please note this is strictly not a race – all speed limits must be adhered to.*

On arrival at Gaydon, there will be an optional “autokhana” driving test, including parking, reversing and driving around cones.

The entry fee of £25 per car and includes rally plate and optional driving tests at Gaydon. Entrance to the car museum at Gaydon is £9 per person, payable on the day. Please see www.heritage-motor-centre.co.uk

Cars will be set off at one minute intervals from the start locations.

The event is untimed and not in any way a race. Speed limits must be adhered to.

Approx mileage for each of the four routes is 120 miles.

For the finish, all routes converge on a central location: The Heritage Motor Centre at Gaydon, Warwickshire.

Drivers must be over 18. No age limit for the navigator, no restriction on number of passengers.

No special equipment necessary – a digital camera or camera phone is required to provide proof of route.

No age restriction on cars - cars of any age are welcome

REGULATIONS

Eligibility

1. All cars must have a V5 Registration Document, display a current Road Fund License disc, and have a valid MOT and insurance cover.
2. Entry is open to cars of all ages. Drivers must be over 18. There is no age limit for passengers.
3. Any person may enter the event. No competition license is required, but all drivers must produce a valid driving license at signing on at the start.

Entries

4. The entry fee is £25 per car. Cheques should be made payable to Continental Car Tours, or phone the CCT office on 01304 380244 with a debit card.
5. Final instructions will be posted one week before the event.
6. Entries must be sent to the organisers:

Route

7. Starting from any one of four start points, North, East, West & South, the event will finish at the Heritage Motor Centre, Gaydon. Each route is approximately 120 miles in total. Starters will be limited to 60 at each start point.
8. The first car will leave each start at 09.01. Others will follow at one minute intervals for road safety reasons, with the first cars arriving at Gaydon from 13.30hrs. The event is due to finish by 17.00.

Documentation

9. Please arrive 30 minutes before the start time for signing on. The following documentation must be available for inspection:
 - Driving licence
 - V5 Registration Document
 - Current MOT Certificate
 - Current Road Fund Licence
10. Each vehicle may be subject to a basic safety check. Any vehicle deemed not appropriate or unsafe will not be allowed to start.
11. Rally plates will be issued at signing on. These should be attached to the front bumper.
