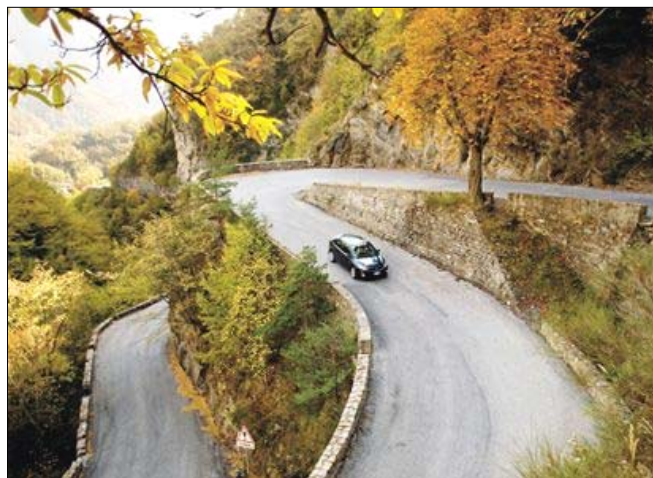

The 2010 Full Monte will re-trace the exciting routes of past Monte Carlo rallies, climbing lots of mountain passes on minor roads from Troyes to Monte Carlo. The drive is exhilarating and the scenery is breathtaking, with overnight halts at 3 star hotels (dinner included most evenings) in Troyes, Aix les Baines, Gap and Nice, where we spend three nights on the Mediterranean coast, just fifteen miles from Monte Carlo. On the return journey we have one night in Grenoble and another night in Troyes before returning to the ferry port.

Leaving on the Saturday we take the ferry from Dover and then drive south on the autoroute to Troyes, just south of Reims, for our first night's hotel – distance 250 miles. Reims was the start for the first stage of the common route throughout the 1960's.

On the second day, the rally route takes us over the Jura mountains to Aix-les-Bains, a popular meeting place for several Monte Carlo rallies – distance 260 miles. Day three, we leave Aix-les-Bains and follow the rally route through the mountains around Grenoble and on to our destination hotel near Gap – distance 195 miles.



Day four is the last leg of the outward journey, with lots more mountain passes, culminating in the most famous of the original rally stages, the Col de Turini at 1600 metres, averaging a gradient of 7.2% over 9 miles. At the top is the Trois Vallées Restaurant, a regular refreshment halt on the rally stage, full of pictures of rallies and rally plates. Then we wind our way down into Nice, to the hotel where we spend three nights – distance approx. 190 miles.

Days five and six are free for you to explore the French Riviera. Take a 15 mile drive along the coast to stunning Monte Carlo, home of the Monaco Grand Prix and traditional finish of the Monte Carlo Rally; 22 miles in the other direction will take you past Antibes to Cannes. Why not take a stroll around Nice old town, or just relax on the beach! To allow you

more flexibility, dinner is not included these two evenings.

Day seven we head off for Grasse, a region famed for perfumery, and continue the drive to Grenoble following the famous Route Napoleon – distance approx. 240 miles.

Day eight we take the main road to Troyes – distance 295 miles. Day nine is again the motorway back to the ferry port – 250 miles.

A spectacular nine day driving tour - approx. 1,700 miles in total.
