HRCR, the premier club dedicated to historic rallying, which celebrated its 25th Anniversary in 2008, has joined forces with Continental Car Tours to present a new one day UK road run.

This event will have four start points, located in the North, East, West and South of England – hence the N.E.W.S. Run.

Entrants will choose one of the start points – Derbyshire, Gloucester, Suffolk or Kent. All routes, designed by experienced HRCR rally crews, are approximately 120 miles long and converge on the Heritage Motor Centre at Gaydon, Warwickshire for the finish.

The HRCR N.E.W.S Run will be a most entertaining event, entirely non-competitive but with plenty to keep both driver and navigator fully occupied, including a tulip route book and marshalled passage controls located in lay-bys, cafes and places of interest. It will run under MSA exemption from permit regulations.

The entry fee of £89 per car includes a year's membership of the HRCR with full member benefits, entry to the car museum at Gaydon, rally plate, route book and finisher's award. *Existing HRCR members pay a discounted fee of £49.

Inclusive entry to the motor museum at Gaydon for a car and two persons.

Cars will be set off at one minute intervals from the start locations and passage controls.

The routes are set on quiet roads and country lanes with transport sections on busier roads.

Each of the four routes have been designed by experienced HRCR rally crews.

The event is untimed and not in any way a competition.

The navigation is by tulip route books and optional jogularity sections navigated by landmarks.

Approx mileage for each of the four routes is 120 miles.

Crews will be required to stop at passage controls on route to get their route card endorsed.

Passage control boards will be placed on the road side for crews to spot and record.

For the finish, all routes converge on a central location: The Heritage Motor Centre at Gaydon, Warwickshire.

No age limit for the navigator, additional passengers £12 per person.

No special equipment necessary.

No age restriction on cars - cars of any age are welcome

REGULATIONS

Organisation

1. Historic Rally Car Register (HRCR) will organise the HRCR N.E.W.S Run, a Touring Assembly on Bank Holiday Monday 4th May 2009
2. The event will be held under a Certificate of Exemption, issued by the Motor Sports Association Ltd., these regulations and any written instructions that the organisers may issue for the event. The MSA Exemption from Permit for the event is number TBA.

Eligibility

3. All cars must have a V5 Registration Document, display a current Road Fund Licence disc, and have a valid MOT and insurance cover. No advertising or competition numbers may be displayed.
4. Entry is open to cars of all ages. There is no age limit for navigators.
5. Any person may enter the event. No competition licence is required, but all drivers must produce a valid driving licence at signing on and all persons travelling in the car must sign on at the start location.

Entries

6. The entry fee is £89 per car with 2 people, or £49 for existing HRCR members. The fee for each additional passenger is £12. Cheques should be made payable to Continental Car Tours, or phone the CCT office on 01304 380244 with a debit card.
7. The full entry fee includes a year's membership of the HRCR for one person and fees include entry to the Heritage Motor Museum for all participants.
8. Final instructions will be posted one week before the event.

10. The Clerk of the Course is David Kirkham and the Secretary of the Event is Tony Barron

Route

11. Starting from any one of four start points, North, East, West & South, the event will finish at the Heritage Motor Centre, Gaydon. Each route is approximately 120 miles in total. Starters will be limited to 60 at each start point.
12. Route instructions by easy to follow Tulip Road Book will be issued at signing on. There may be other types of route instruction for optional use.
13. The first car will leave each start at 09.01. Others will follow at one minute intervals for road safety reasons, with the first cars arriving at Gaydon from 13.30hrs. The event is due to finish by 17.00.
14. Along the route there will be marshalled passage controls (PC) where you must stop to get your route card signed. There will be adequate time to visit PCs while they are open. There will also be code boards to observe and part of the route may be a Jogularity section optionally navigated via landmarks. All marshals are deemed judges of fact.

Documentation

15. Please arrive 45 minutes before the start time for signing on. Everyone in the vehicle must sign on at the start. The following documentation must be available for inspection:

- Driving licence
- V5 Registration Document
- Current MOT Certificate
- Current Road Fund Licence

16. Each vehicle may be subject to a basic safety check. Any vehicle deemed not appropriate or unsafe will not be allowed to start.

17. Rally plates will be issued at signing on. These should be attached to the front bumper.
